

## **Kansas Junior Livestock Show Showmanship Contests**

Each species will be divided into a Junior (7-9), Intermediate (10-13) and Senior (14 and over) division, according to the exhibitor's age on January 1 of the current show year. For specific questions, contact the appropriate Superintendent.

1. The Contest is open to any KJLS exhibitor. Any exhibitor may enter the contest by paying a \$5 entry fee per division. Refer to the KJLS Schedule for specific time. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for the showmanship contest. Each participant must use his or her own animal that they have entered for the showmanship contest.
2. Late Entries: Late entries for showmanship will be accepted through August 25 but will be subject to a \$10 entry fee per division. There will be no entries accepted on-site.
3. Classes: Classes will be a random sort within the age divisions. Exhibitors are required to show in their assigned heat.
4. Premiums: No premiums will be distributed to the exhibitors in showmanship classes. Showmanship entry fees will be utilized to cover the costs associated with providing a showmanship opportunity for all exhibitors.
5. Selection of Winners: The judge will have the right to select as many or as few youth as they would like from each class to participate in the finals of the age division of showmanship for the species. Only the top five youth competing in the finals for their age division will be ranked 1 – 5.
