

# 2020 Kansas Junior Livestock Show

## LEAD Contest Results

In its fifth year, the LEAD Challenge had 61 exhibitors compete, including 26 juniors, 19 intermediates, and 16 seniors. The challenge consisted of four main components: Listen & Learn sessions, livestock showmanship, skill stations, and a career development activity. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Listen & Learn sessions, career development activity, and presentation portion of the skill stations were held virtually. The test portion of the skill stations and livestock showmanship were held in-person.

Top five finishers overall in each age division will be mailed a physical and cash prize separately. In each division, first place will receive a leather padfolio and number holder, second place will receive a leather picture frame, third place will receive a lunch box, fourth place will receive a water bottle, and fifth place will receive a hat. Juniors will receive \$300 for first place, \$200 for second place, \$100 for third place, \$50 for fourth place, and \$25 for fifth place. Intermediates will receive \$400 for first place, \$300 for second place, \$200 for third place, \$100 for fourth place, and \$75 for fifth place. Seniors will receive \$500 for first place, \$400 for second place, \$300 for third place, \$200 for fourth place, and \$100 for fifth place.
